## The "PREVENT" Strategy

- Responds to the ideological challenge we face from terrorism and aspects of extremism, and the threat we face from those who promote these views.
- Provides practical help to prevent people from being drawn into terrorism and ensure they are given appropriate advice and support
- Works with a wide range of sectors (including education, criminal justice, faith, charities online and health) where there are risks of radicalisation that we need to deal with.
- Cover all forms of terrorism, including far right extremism and some aspects of non-violent extremism.

Referral of any concerns via safeguarding staff to the relevant authorities



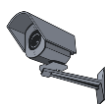
**E**
